1. About the Programme

ITEP is a 4-year integrated teacher education programme approved by the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. ITEP is a Dual Major Programme -the first major is in Education with School Specific Stage specialization and the second major is in an opted discipline It prepares graduates for teaching at the Secondary level. The programme integrates subject knowledge, pedagogical skills, and professional practice over four years.

Admission is based on the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA).

6. How to Apply — Step-by-Step Guide

Step 1: Visit University Admission Portal

Go to <http://itep.ccsuforms.in/> and navigate to ITEP Admissions 2026–27. Click on 'Registration form for ITEP Admission'.

Step 2: Fill Registration Form

Enter your personal details, academic qualifications, and NCET detail accurately. Upload your passport photograph, signature and required documents.

Step 3: Select Programme & Institutes

Choose B.A. B.Ed. or B.Sc. B.Ed. Select up to 4 institutes and rank them by preference (1 = most preferred).

Step 4: Pay Counselling Fee

Pay the non-refundable counselling fee of ₹500 via UPI, Net Banking, or Debit/Credit Card.

Step 5: Submit & Print

Review all entries carefully, accept the declaration, and submit the form. Print and retain a copy of the submitted form and payment receipt.
